HDSA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Program Philosophy Statement

To carry out our commitment to the honorary members of the association, the Teller County Sheriff's Office Honorary Deputy Sheriff's Association established a scholarship program. This effort has as a meaningful expression of the HDSA's confidence in and respect for education and training. The HDSA considers this an investment in the future and believes that our membership is helping to provide deserving students with an opportunity to make a positive contribution to society as a whole.

The HDSA, through its honorary membership program, will be awarding one \$1,000 scholarship every other academic school year.

Eligibility

This year we will be accepting applications through **April 28, 2023**, for awards applicable to the 2023/2024 academic year. If you are a permanent resident of Teller County, please apply by the April 23, 2023, deadline.

Any permanent legal resident of Teller County who plans to enroll in a vocational training program or institution of higher learning in the state of Colorado as a full-time or part-time student for 2023-2024 school year is eligible. Applicants must reside in Teller County to qualify for the HDSA scholarship.

Those who have received scholarships in the previous years may apply again and be considered for an additional award.

Applicants must be legal residents of the United States and eligible for admission or readmission to the school(s) or institution(s) of learning indicated in the application. **The award will only be paid for attendance at certified schools or institutions of learning within the state of Colorado.**

There shall be no restrictions as to the course of study or training pursued. No restrictions shall be placed by reason of race, creed, color, age, sex or national origin.

Terms

Applicants must maintain good standing in their chosen program.

HDSA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Obtaining an Application

Applications may be obtained through our website at <https://www.tellercountyhdsa.org/>, or by contacting the Teller County Sheriff's Office. They may be typed or hand written.

Application Filing Deadline

All applications must be submitted to the Teller County Sheriff's Office no later than **April 21, 2023**.

Selection

Applications received by the Teller County Sheriff's Office will be reviewed by a citizen's committee selected by the HDSA board. One scholarship recipient and two runners up will be selected.

Announcement of Award

The final selection process is to be completed in time to allow the award announcement by May 10, 2023. Award will be presented to recipient by HDSA board members and the Teller County Sheriff as soon thereafter as possible.
